

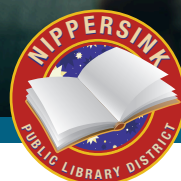

Grab and Go Service: Library building to open September 29!

Nippersink Library will open to the public on a limited basis starting Tuesday, September 29.

Grab and Go Service hours are:

9 AM to 1 PM: Tuesday, Wednesday & Saturday

9 AM to 10 AM: Tuesday and Wednesday will be reserved for seniors and those with compromised immune systems.

We ask all patrons to limit their visit to no more than 30 minutes. There will be no public seating or tables. All toys and games have been removed from the Children's area. There will be no in-person programming. Meeting rooms will remain closed.

We have two public computers available which will be scheduled by appointment only. Please call the library at 815-678-4014 to schedule an appointment.

Library visitors must follow these safety guidelines:

- Face masks must be worn properly at all times (ages 2 and up). If you can't wear a mask, please call us to schedule curbside service
- Maintain six feet of social distance at all times between staff and other patrons
- Follow all traffic pattern signs

Curbside Service hours will be modified as follows:

Monday & Thursday: 9 AM to 7 PM

Tuesday & Wednesday: 1 PM to 7 PM

Friday: 9 AM to 4 PM & Saturday: 1 PM to 4 PM

Book Drops: All materials must be returned to the outside book drops. *Please do not bring materials into the building.* All returned items must be quarantined for seven days so there will be a delay before items are checked in and removed from your library card.

With no waiting, titles can be streamed immediately, or downloaded to phones or tablets for offline enjoyment later. hoopla has hundreds of thousands of titles to choose from, with more being added daily. hoopla is like having your public library at your fingertips. Library Mobile App coming soon!

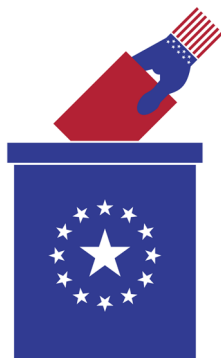
We are in the process of developing a mobile app for our patrons. Check our website for more information as we get ready to launch the app.

District 2021 Trustee Elections

Petitions for nomination and other required documents for candidates for the Nippersink Public Library District Board of Trustees will be available at the library beginning Tuesday, September 22. The documents and the 2021 Candidate's Guide are also available on the State Board of Elections website (www.elections.state.il.us).

Four 4-year terms will be on the ballot for the April 6, 2021 Consolidated Election. The petition filing period begins December 14 and the filing deadline is 5:00 PM on Monday, December 21. Petitions may be filed with the library director, Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9 AM and 5 PM. New terms will begin Monday, May 17, 2021.

The Board of Trustees is the governing body of the library district. The trustees' primary responsibilities are to determine general library policies, oversee library finances, and be an advocate for library services in the community and throughout the state. Regular board meetings are held the second Tuesday of each month at 7:00 PM.

Prospective candidates must be a registered voter and a resident of the library district, which includes Richmond Township and most of Burton Township. If you would like a nominating packet, please contact Library Director Cynthia Cole at 815-678-4014 and we can arrange for curbside pickup or mail a packet to you.
