Call to Order

New Business

A. Facilities Assessment Presentation

Rick McCarthy discussed the methodology for the assessment, including life cycle analysis and cost replacement estimates. He also reviewed the Excel worksheet that is delivered as part of the assessment. A wide array of data can be extracted from the workbook and it represents a "living" tool for tracking and anticipating facility costs.

Rick also reviewed the areas of greatest concern, including the elevator, HVAC, and roof replacement. Rick discussed some of the timing issues for each project and the need to focus on the next 5-6 years of building projects for budgeting purposes.

Discussion ensued regarding the elevator which constitutes our most immediate challenge and the other work that may be necessary to complete the upgrade and improvements. Director Cole advised the elevator upgrade would be on the agenda for the June meeting.

Rick also advised that our building is larger than most libraries with our service population, while our revenue is lower, and we should perhaps consider working with a financial planner on how to bridge the gap.
