306 Patron Conduct

To insure that all patrons may have trouble-free use of the Nippersink Public Library, appropriate behavior is expected. Violation of any of the following rules will result in a warning and/or expulsion from the property. This list is not comprehensive and any behavior that is deemed by library staff to be disruptive to the library, or anyone using the facility, may result in disciplinary action. Whenever necessary, police will be contacted. The Library Director and supervisory staff have authority to carry out all powers of this policy.

1. No loud talking or boisterous behavior (running, excessive seat changing, etc.)

2. No food or drink may be consumed in the library (excepting with prior approval of the Library Director).

3. No smoking inside the library building or within 15 feet of any entrance to the library building.

4. No destruction or mutilation of library property.

5. No parking bicycles or other vehicles in a manner that blocks or hinders entry to the library.

6. No skateboarding or rollerblading on library property at any time.

7. No conduct that is disruptive to the operation of the library or threatening to patrons, staff or library property.

8. No inappropriate attire is allowed. Shirt and shoes must be worn at all times.

9. No pets of any kind are allowed in the library except in the case of a library-related program or a service dog. Animals may not be tethered on library property.

10. No entry to the library if you have neglected your bodily hygiene so that it gives offense and constitutes a nuisance to other patrons.
